


# PEP AS THE SKY, RED AS THE SEA



#### I am a Meadow Mermaid by Kallie George


A farm girl with a big imagination turns her landlocked home into an ocean playground in this dreamy picture book for little mermaids everywhere.


#### Hope Is the First Dose by W. Lee Warren, M.D.








## Rewild your Garden by Frances Tophill
