The Stettler Public Library is seeking an enthusiastic, creative, and organized **Teen Summer Program Coordinator** for the 2025 summer season (May 5 - August 22). This position offers an exciting opportunity to design and implement an engaging "**Around the World**" themed literacy program, encouraging teen participation in reading and educational activities. The coordinator will work closely with the **Summer Program Coordinator** to deliver dynamic programming tailored for three age groups: **5-7, 8-10, and 11 and up**.

Position Details:

- Hours: 35 hours per week, primarily Monday to Friday, with occasional evening or Saturday shifts.
- Term: May 5 – August 22, 2025.

Key Responsibilities

- **Program Development:** Collaborate to design and implement age-appropriate activities, including themed displays, contests, and family events, ensuring adaptability as needed.
- **Community Engagement:** Establish partnerships with local schools and community organizations, conduct outreach visits, and coordinate guest speakers.
- **Promotion:** Design and distribute print and digital promotional materials working with team members and local organizations to enhance program visibility.
- **Administration:** Manage program budget, track attendance, maintain records, compile statistics, and prepare program evaluations.

Qualifications:

- Proficiency in English and excellent computer skills.
- Experience working with teens and/or knowledge of public library operations is an asset.
- Demonstrated maturity, reliability, creativity, and enthusiasm for teen engagement.
- Background in education, sciences, drama, storytelling, or musical performance is advantageous.
- Previous experience leading teen activities in a group setting is preferred.
- A valid driver's license and access to a vehicle are considered assets.

Conditions of Employment:

- Successful completion of a criminal record/vulnerable sector check.
- Meeting eligibility requirements of the Young Canada Works program.
