

LIBRARY MEMBERSHIP

Starting in 2019, Olds & area residents are eligible for a free library card. Please bring a piece of ID showing your local address.

- Non-Resident \$60
- Non-Profit & Assoc: \$35
- Lost library cards \$1.00 replacement fee.
- Children under 16 years of age must be part of a family membership.
- Memberships are good for 1 year.

OVERDUE FINES



- 25 CENTS per item / day
 example: 10 items overdue for 1 day = \$2.50
- Overdue notices are sent via email
- Please ask for a due slip during check-out



RENEWALS

- Most materials can be renewed up to five
 (5) times in person, by phone or online.
- If another member has requested the item, it may not be renewed.
- Renewals may not be possible if there are unpaid fines or charges on your card or if your membership expires

- Check your holds, see what you have out, and renew your books online.

- Click "Login"
- Enter your Library Card number and PIN*
 *last 4 digits of your phone number

- To place a hold, ask at our front desk, phone or use our online catalogue.
- You will be contacted when a held item becomes available.
- Items will be held for 5 business days.
 If not picked up the item will be given to the next person on the waiting list, or be re-shelved.

THE ME CARD



- Your ME Card allows you to check out items from other participating Alberta public libraries.
- Complete the online web form at **melibraries.ca** to create an account with the participating libraries of your choice.
- Use your library card at the libraries you registered with.
- All items borrowed at participating libraries can be returned to any ME library.
