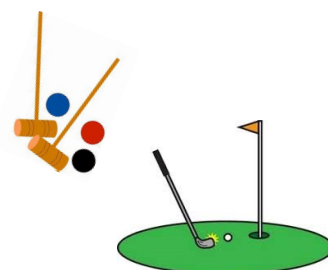
Kick-off to Summer!

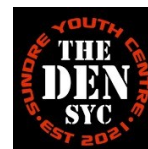

SRC Explore It: Explore It days give the kids an opportunity to check out some of our in-house tech and cool science based activities for kids aged 4-12.

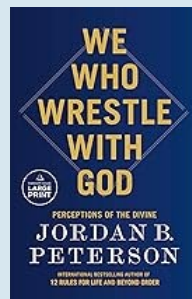
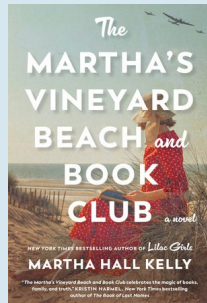
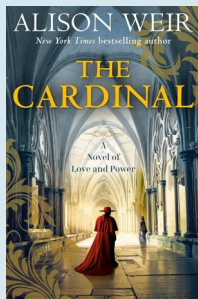
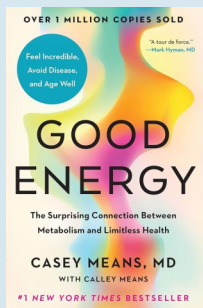
