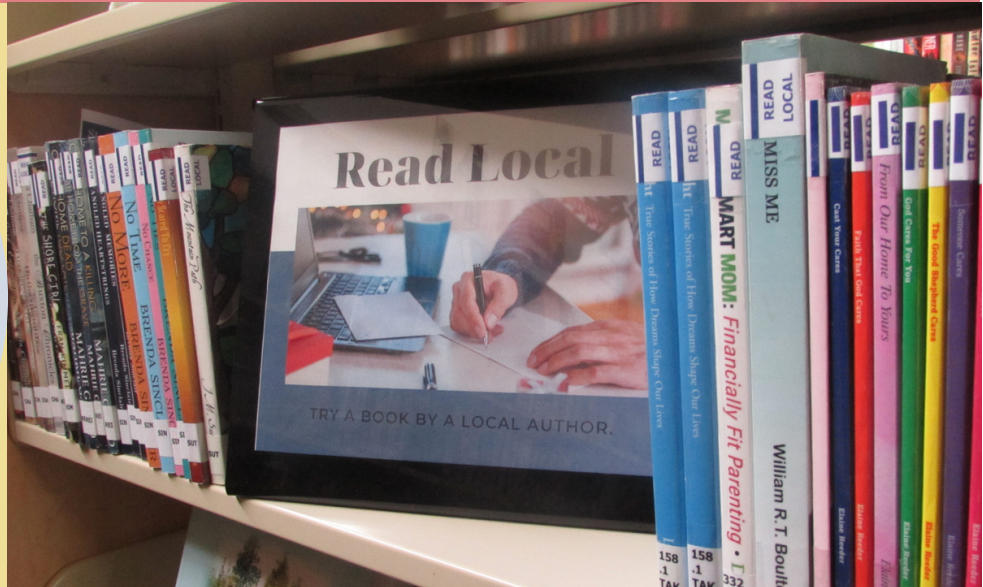

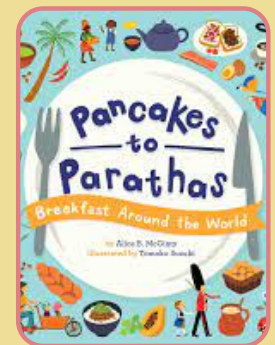

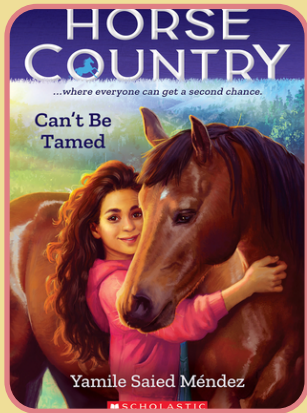

How do we participate in the 6 hour reading challenge?

1. Get a Beanstack account. (see our website under services/beanstack for full details)
2. Start Reading! Use the timer in Beanstack or a clock to track how many minutes you read.
3. When you get to 6 hours you will earn a digital ticket in Beanstack. Choose which of our 5 Grand Prize draws you want to enter.
4. Come to the library and show us you finished 6 hours and collect your super special 6 hour prize and collect a button to show your achievement!
5. Keep reading! Every time you get to another 6 hours you get another digital ticket.

What are all the badges for?

Every badge you get in Beanstack you can collect a real pin version to add to your collection so stop by the library often to share your progress. Some badges unlock digital tickets that get you prize draw entries. Complete the basic set of badges to unlock your completion certificate. Can you collect them all? Check out the reviews, and activities badges to earn even more digital tickets and more chances to win.

What can I read?

Anything! Picture books, chapter books, beginning readers, audiobooks, graphic novels, the newspaper and epic series. All reading counts. It even counts if someone reads to you or you read to someone else.

How to Beanstack

If you have ever used Beanstack before just **Sign In and Register** for challenges.

Forgot your password? Beanstack offers "User Name" & "Password" recover options

Click **I am Registering myself** and fill out the form.

If you need to you can recover a name & password.

Click **Next** to add additional family members.

Register for our **Challenges**. Beanstack will automatically present the challenges that fits your age group. We will be adding new challenges so check back as we add more.

Begin tracking your reading and activities by clicking **Log Reading and Activities** on the top left of the page.

- Use the **drop-down menu under your name** to switch readers and log for a child's account.
- Beanstack will notify you by email if you've won a prize. Or, check **earned badges** in the challenge.
- Select the **gear setting** (top right of screen) to edit a reader's information, such as email.

App Version

Download the app from your favorite play store

Open App, Touch **Find Your School or Library**.

Type in "Carstairs Public Library."

Touch **Sign up!**

Follow the prompts to enter a User Name, Email (optional) and Password

Follow the prompts to complete the Registration for you.

Touch **Add a Reader** for additional family members

Touch **Discover** at the bottom of the screen to register for the reading challenges that matches your age.

Touch the + (**Plus sign**) to log reading. You can scan, search, or manually enter the title.

- Use **Choose reader** to log for others.
- **Quick Log** will log a book all at once.
- Use **Start a Reading Session** to track pages or minutes, or Log Past Reading.
- **Log** shows you books and activities you've recorded

You can Switch Readers by touching the initials at the top right of the app screen. You may also add a reader or edit your information from the Account screen.

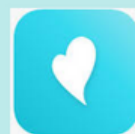
The Beanstack Tracker App will sync with the web version. If you log on the app, it will also appear on the web version. Make sure you've registered for a challenge for your books to count!

The Beanstack mobile app is like a fitness tracker, but for reading. Easily see your reading "stats," track reading for multiple readers, receive logging reminders, and view your reading "streaks" and achievements. The Beanstack Tracker App will synch all of your programs. Log a book in the app, and it will add to your challenges automatically!

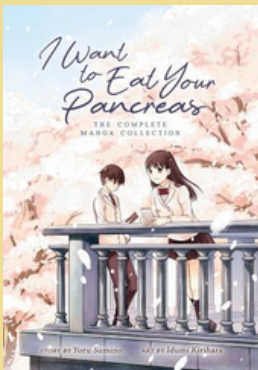
6 Hour Reading Challenge

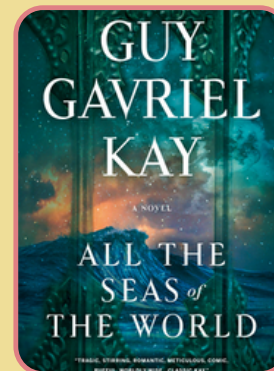

Blind Date with a Book



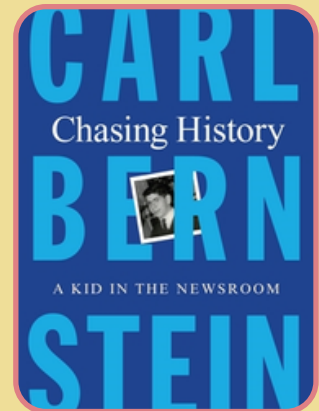

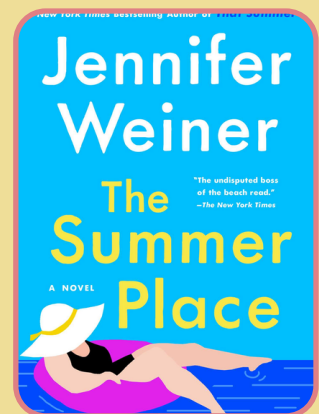
