“the most delicious event of the year!”

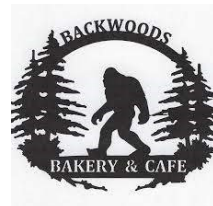
...and it's BACK!

Edison Sumo Wrestlers - Wednesday, March 9th, 4:00—5:00 pm

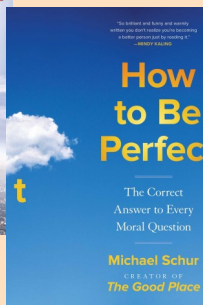
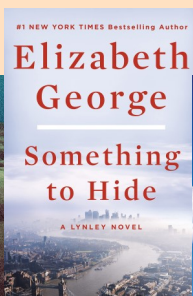
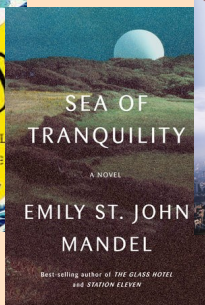
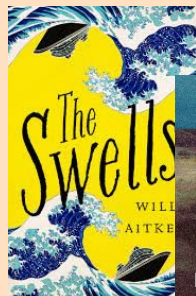
Use Scratch coding to manipulate an Edison Robot. This workshop is hands on. Explore the connection between computer programming and electronics. **Grades 3-5.**
