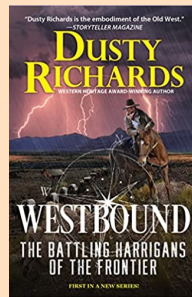
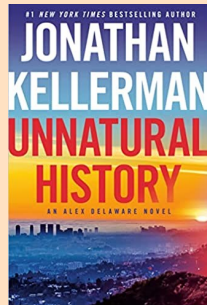
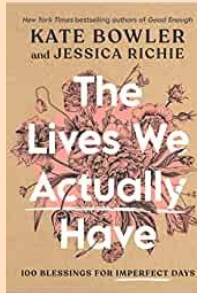
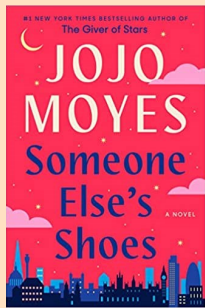
Wonders of Wildlife: Birds Part 2

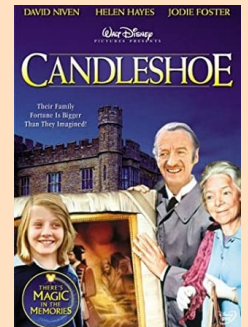
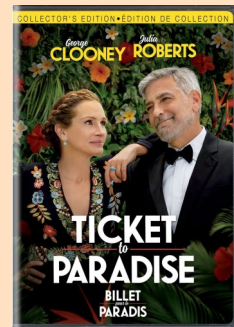

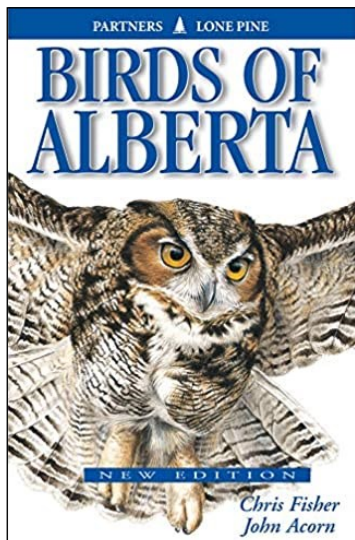
