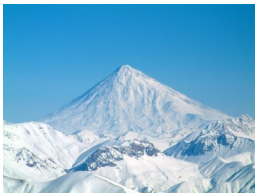

Chinese Art Exhibit: The Silk Road

The Silk Road was an ancient trade route that linked the Western world with the Middle East and Asia. A series of traders transferred goods along its more than 6,400 km length. Silk moved west, while wool, gold, and silver traveled east.

This exhibit features a display with silk worm cocoons and sumptuous silks created from them. Come see these splendid silk fabrics, as well as oriental ceramics and sculptures, a Chinese tea display, and Chinese painted scrolls.
